In terms of civil society:

Every employee has the right to be secured by an appropriate level of the subsistence minimum;

Everyone has the right to receive a hygienically safe and pleasant stay in the hotel;

Every hotel should take care of hiring a law-abiding cleaning company which is mandatory guided in their actions by the norms of the Labor code, to avoid complaints.
